- Gaps



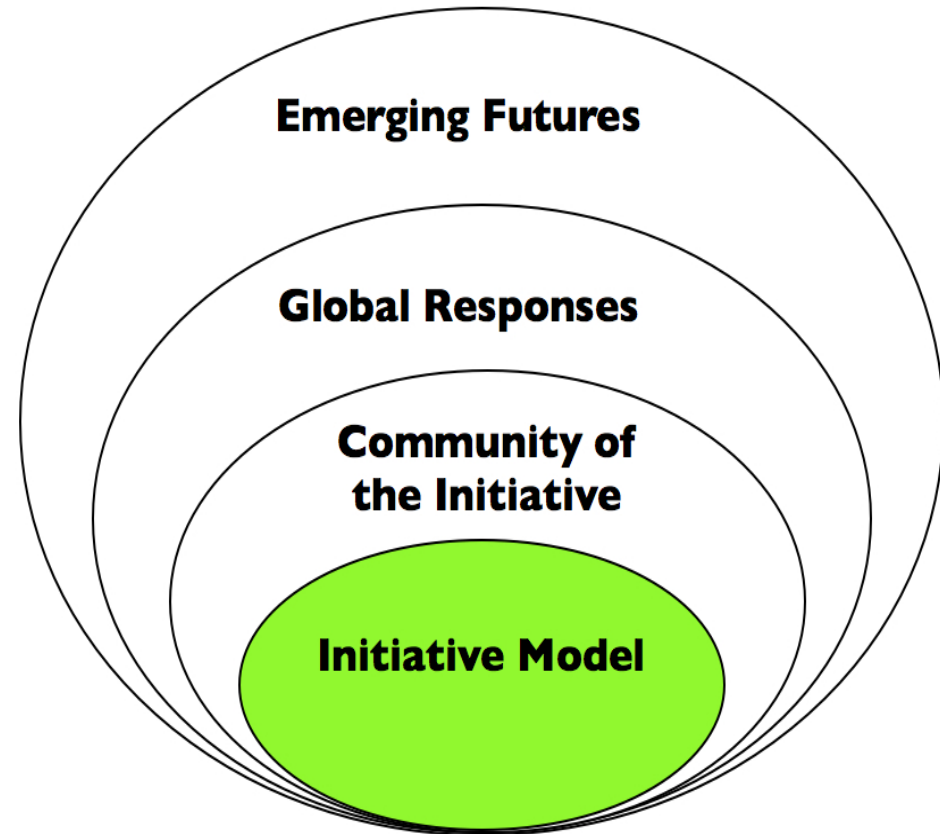
# Community of the Initiative

  - Co-creation of value

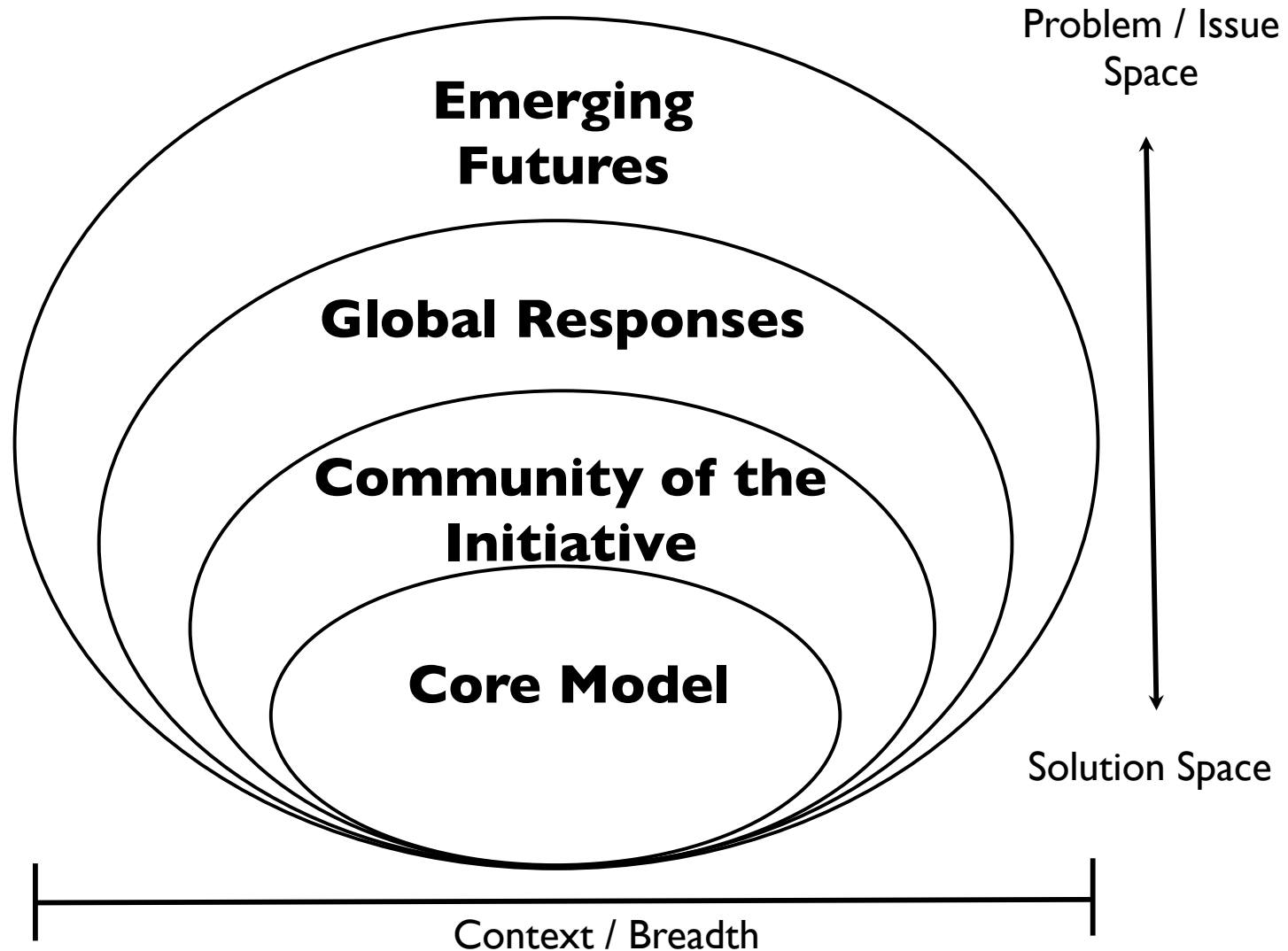


# Initiative Model

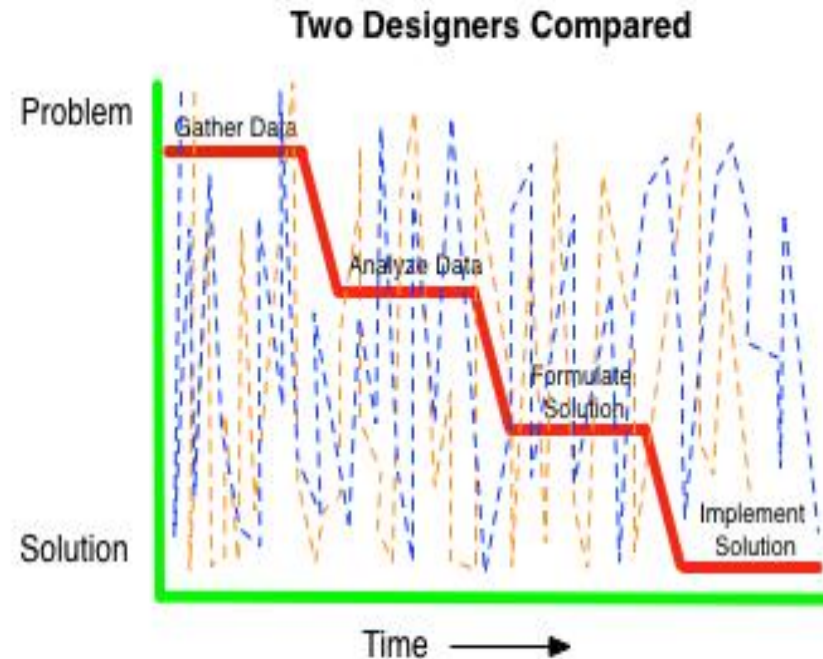
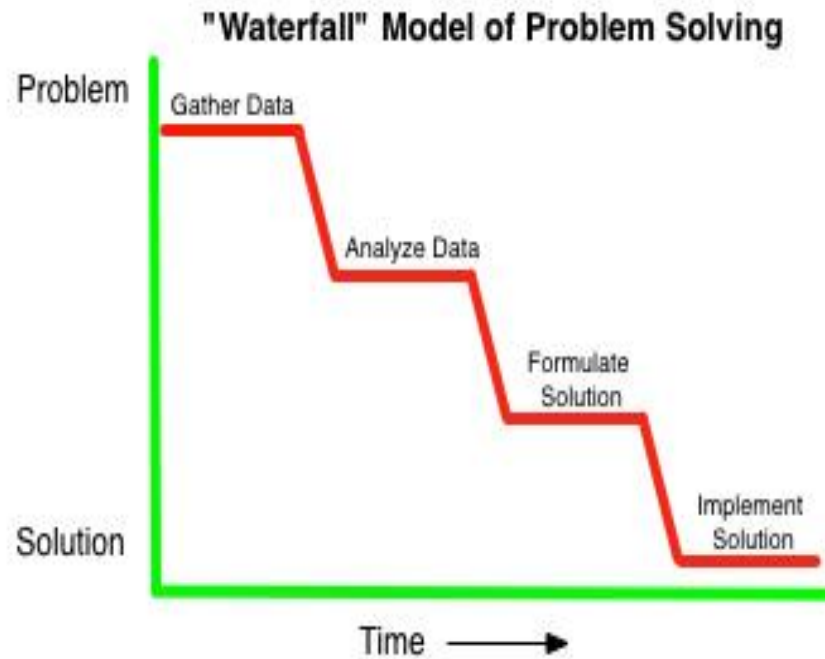
- Purpose

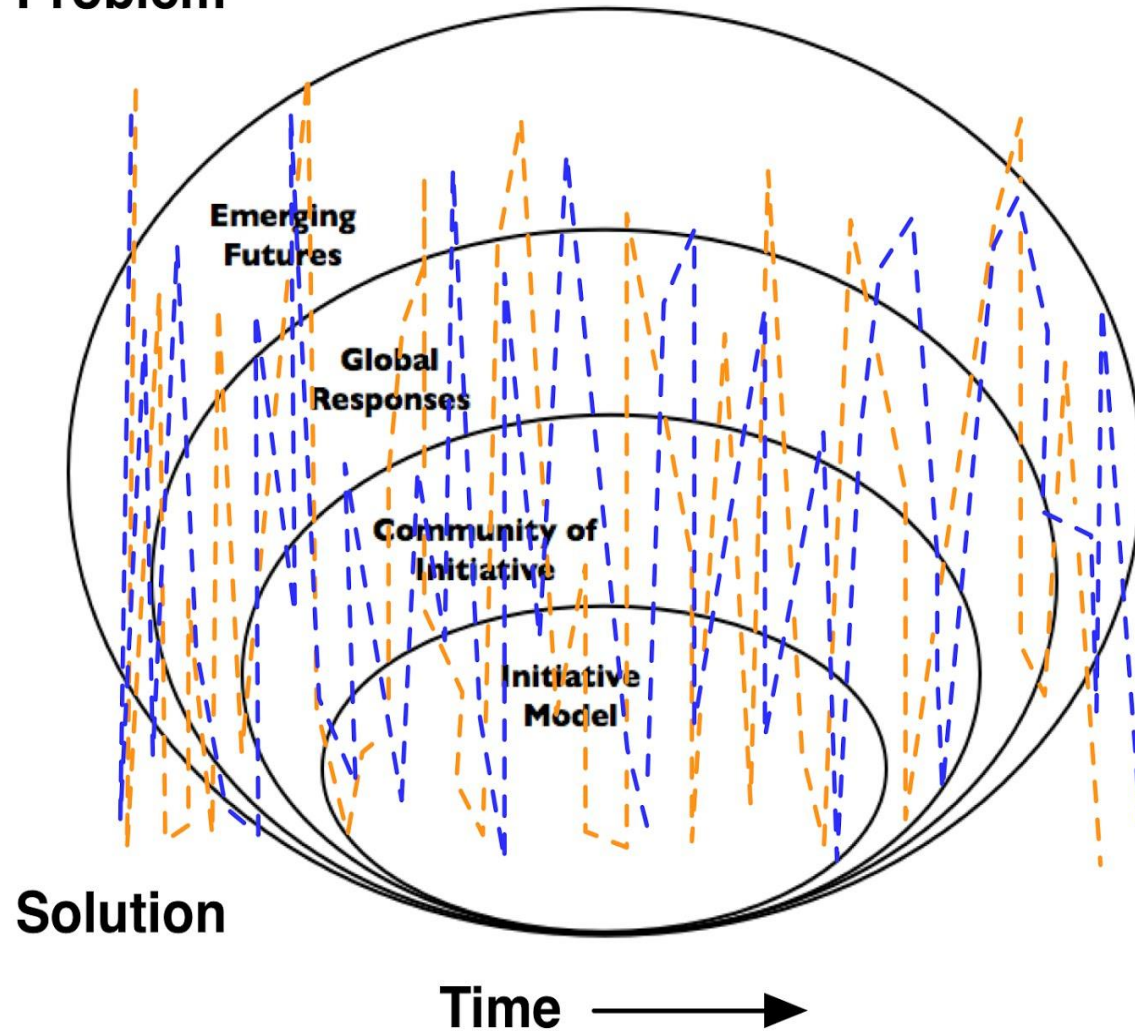
